**AB 495 – Model Policies for Child
Daycare and California State
Preschool Programs**

AB 495 – Related to Child Daycares and CSPPs

- Adds Health & Safety Code § 1597.640
 - ✓ Prohibits licensed daycare facilities & license-exempt California State Preschool Programs (CSPPs) from collecting information/documents regarding citizenship or immigration status of children or their family members (with exceptions).
 - ✓ Requires reporting of requests for information/access to facilities for immigration enforcement purposes.
 - ✓ Emergency contact information requirements.
 - ✓ Requires AGO to issue model policies by April 1, 2026.
 - CSPPs must adopt by July 1, 2026.
- Amends Family Code § 6550
 - ✓ Broaden ability to make plans if parent is unavailable.
- Amends Education Code § 234.7
 - ✓ Prohibit voluntary access to nonpublic areas of schoolsites for immigration enforcement purposes.
