#### Competitive Integrated Employment or "CIE"

- "<u>Competitive</u>" means: Customary wage and benefits
- "Integrated" means: A location where the employee interacts with other persons who are not individuals with disabilities
- "Employment" means: Paid work "Real Work for Real Pay in the Real World"

- Received input in writing via the California CIE inbox, <u>CaliforniaCIE@dor.ca.gov</u>.



  - Business partner engagement


# The Blueprint is nearing completion
