

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY

Title 22 California Code of Regulations. SOCIAL SECURITY

Division 2. Department of Social Services – Department of Health Services

Chapter 2 of Subdivision 1. Conflict of Interest Code

10100. General Provisions.

The Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81100, et seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, (2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730) that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference. This regulation and the attached Appendices, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the **California Health and Human Services Agency (CalHHS)**.

The Secretary must file their statements of economic interests electronically with the **Fair Political Practices Commission**. All other individuals holding designated positions must file their statements with the **CalHHS**. All statements must be made available for public inspection and reproduction under Government Code Section 81008.

VII. Consultants/New Positions

Consultants & New Positions	*
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*Consultants/new positions shall be included in the list of designated positions and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest disclosure category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Agency Secretary or designee may determine in writing that a particular consultant or new position, although a “designated position,” is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and, thus, is not required to comply fully with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant’s or new position’s duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Agency Secretary’s or designee’s determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code. (Gov. Code Sec. 81008.)

Appendix B

Disclosure Categories

Category 1

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

All investments and business positions in business entities, sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments) and real property located in the state of California.

Category 2

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

All investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans and travel payments).

Category 3

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

Interests in real property located in the State of California that are used by the CalHHS Office of Technology and Solutions Integration, or are of the type that could be acquired by the CalHHS Office of Technology and Solutions Integration, as well as real property within two miles of the property used or the potential site that could be acquired.

In addition, investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments) if the business entity or source provides 1) leased facilities, goods, equipment, vehicles, machinery, software, hardware, or services (including training or consulting services) of the type utilized by the CalHHS Office of Technology and Solutions Integration, or 2) are subject to the project management or oversight of the CalHHS Office of Technology and Solutions Integration.

Category 4

Designated positions assigned to this category must report:

Investments and business positions in business entities and sources of income (including receipt of gifts, loans, and travel payments) if the business entity or source provides 1) leased facilities, goods, equipment, vehicles, machinery, software, hardware, or services (including training or consulting services) of the type utilized by the Office of Systems Integration, or 2) are subject to the project management or oversight of the CalHHS Office of Technology and Solutions Integration.
