

# **Planning Considerations**

- Historically, the MPA initiatives are updated every two years. The next planning cycle would begin in 2026.
- Exploring alternatives to convening a large-scale "MPA Day of Action" to present MPA Stakeholder Committee recommendations.
- Governor & Administration Transition
  - Election Day: Tuesday, November 3, 2026.
  - New Governor takes office January 2027.
  - MPA initiatives beyond 2026 need to align with the priorities of the new Governor & Administration.
