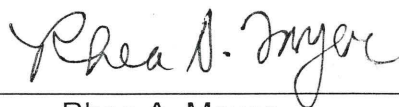

Division 2. Department of Social Services – Department of Health Services

Chapter 2 of Subdivision 1. Conflict of Interest Code

10100. General Provisions.

The Political Reform Act, (~~Government Code sections~~ Section 81100, et seq.), requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, (~~2~~ California Code of Regulations, title 2, section Section 18730), that contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing, the standard code may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations, ~~title 2, section~~ Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated by reference, along with the attached Appendices in which officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, are hereby incorporated by reference and This regulation and the attached Appendices, designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the conflict of interest code of the ~~California Health and Human Services Agency (CHHSA).~~ California Health and Human Services Agency (CalHHS).

The Secretary must file ~~his/her~~ their statements of economic interests electronically with the ~~Fair Political Practices Commission.~~ Fair Political Practices Commission. All other individuals holding designated positions must file their statements with the ~~CHHSA~~ CalHHS. All statements must be made available for public inspection and reproduction under Government Code Section 81008.
