## Peer-to-Peer Recruitment Part 2: Skills & Strategies for Responding

Join us for Part 2 of our peer-to-peer recruitment series, focused on practical strategies for assessing, preventing, and responding to peer recruitment behaviors.

This session will build on the concepts introduced in Part 1 and explore how professionals can respond to different levels of recruitment behavior while supporting both youth initiating recruitment and youth impacted by it.

### During the session, participants will:

- Assess recruitment behaviors along a spectrum from typical to concerning to clearly problematic or coercive
- Explore prevention strategies, including communication, clear expectations, safety planning, harm reduction, and education
- Practice ways to understand the triggers, needs, and consequences connected to recruitment behaviors
- Consider strategies for accountability, support, supervision, and more intensive intervention when needed
