



## **Summary of Vision Narrative Readouts from Meeting #2**

The full Committee reconvened following the breakout discussions to share what was discussed regarding the follow-up feedback on the Vision for Success. The recommendations for CalHHS included the following:

- Clarify the use of the terms “system” and “systems” to understand which goals relate to DDS and which refer to broader topics.
- Establish a clear definition of “high quality” to ensure alignment on what high quality care delivery entails.
- Reframe success as ensuring individuals can thrive, rather than simply having basic needs being met.
- Establish a clear definition of what “data driven” means and ensure the individuals’ experiences are incorporated into planning to develop a truly holistic picture, including the role of equity in the lived experience.
- Ensure that addressing all needs for success are considered throughout the consumer’s whole lifespan.
- Clarify timelines when describing success to ensure individuals receive services and supports when they require them.
- The Vision for Success should consider the experiences of those who are not currently receiving developmental disability services but who may benefit from them, given the access issues at hand.
- Incorporate accountability throughout the themes:
  - Establish metrics to judge RC performance and ensure data sharing across systems
  - Provide further guidance to individuals and families to navigate the service system
- Support the development of a diverse and stable workforce by educating potential candidates about career opportunities and more pathways to careers working with the DD community.
