

**Commercial Sexual Exploitation Identification Tool Pilot Test  
Preliminary Data**

These data are preliminary results from a study with ongoing data collection. They can be used to understand the prevalence of commercial sexual exploitation among youth in the respective agencies, but should not be generalized to all youth who experience commercial sexual exploitation. Caution should be used in interpreting the results, as the sample sizes are small. Because these results are preliminary, they may not represent the final results.
