Global Data Sharing Agreement	The 3-way Memorandum of Understanding between CDSS, DHCS and counties allows for easy exchange of health and medication information for children with child welfare cases. At present, twelve counties have opted into the Global Data Sharing Agreement and other counties continue to show interest as they opt in on a flow basis. A webinar was offered in August 2015 describing psychotropic medication data sharing efforts which included details and benefits for counties opting into the agreement. California Child Welfare Services Case Management – New System	An alternative path for the Request for Proposal (RFP) will be pursued by the state for procurement of the New System.
