**\*Note:** Proposition 1C, Housing Emergency Shelter Trust Fund Act of 2006, was approved by voters in November 2006. This measure authorized the State to sell \$2.85 billion of general obligation bonds to fund 13 new and existing housing and development programs. The funds will assist eligible projects to build affordable and accessible housing for individuals with lower incomes in their communities over the next ten years.
