ECPC Charter

Purpose

- To advise the Governor, the Legislature, and the Superintendent of Public Instruction on statewide early learning and care policy
- Prepare a formal public annual report
- Provide specific recommendations on all aspects of the state's early childhood system including:
 - Equity
 - Accountability
 - Opportunities
 - Ways the MPELC and BRC can be updated/improved



ECPC Charter

Membership and Commitment

- 27 members from diverse backgrounds and perspectives—appointed by Governor, Legislature, Superintendent and Council committees.
- Members serve three-year terms and no more than two terms.
- Council will convene at least 4 times per year. Members are expected to attend a majority of those meetings. Meetings are subject to Bagley-Keene.
