



DISCUSSION



- Current research shows poor quality CST reports.
 - I. Lacked thoroughness.
 - 2. Lacked DSM diagnosis.
 - 3. Failed to link mental disorder with competency deficits.

DISCUSSION

- A few lacked competency opinion or related abilities.
- Over 50% did not provide DSM diagnosis.
- Most lacked a DSM diagnosis justification.
- Less than 20% linked mental disorder with CST impairments.
- Minimal use of structured assessments.

DISCUSSION

- Training is critical for improving the quality of CST reports:
 - Thoroughness.
 - Adherence to professional standards and guidelines.
 - Use scientific methods (structured assessments).
