1	Michael Marchant	<p>Thank you very much, Michael Marchant with UC Davis. So just a couple of quick comments quite a lot in the Q&A so if you read through the Q&A you'll get most of it, but just to highlight is the language around point one around EHR the technology stack and the people that are going to be exchanging organizations may or may not be on an EHR so we may want to look at changing that language, like the PCRs and for EMS and there's some others that Claudia pointed or that Bill pointed out in the chat.</p> <p>The other piece is just really again making sure that we increase or create some additional work groups to deal with some of the messier issues around identity and consent that we talked about today, and some of the other pieces. I know we have one subgroup, but I think this organization that based on the regulations we need to move quicker and be and be active and doing these things on a more regular cadence, and so I would encourage the advisory council to commission additional work groups and to try to move things along a little bit quicker. It just feels like we're going to get to next year when we need to have something done and we're going to have way too many spaces or holes in what we're trying to do.</p> <p>And again, just continue to leverage the existing work. I know Dr Lane's done a great job putting a lot of things that exist out in the chat or in the Q&A, and I would just encourage the advisory council to leverage as much of that as possible, as we move this forward, thank you.</p>
