CCJBH Background


The Council on Criminal Justice and Behavioral Health (CCJBH) is a 12-member council

Chaired by the Secretary of the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation

Established by California Penal Code Section 6044(a)

Aim to reduce the incarceration of youth and adults with serious mental illness and substance use disorders

CCJBH hosts quarterly Full Council Meetings and bi-monthly workgroups focused on Juvenile Justice and Diversion/Reentry

≻The contract includes:

- Evidence-based and Emerging Practices and Programs Compendium
- System Capacity Development Toolkit
- Training and Technical Assistance (TTA) Plan
- ➤The RFP was originally posted in October 2021, then reposted from December 9, 2021, to February 4, 2022.
- The contract was awarded to the RAND Corporation and was executed on April 13, 2022.



Future Contract Activities

➤CCJBH and RAND will meet for a Contract Kick Off Meeting in early May 2022.

➤Contract timeline:

- February 2023: Completion of Compendium
- December 2023: Completion of Toolkit
- April 2024: Completion of TTA Plan

CCJBH staff will collaborate with the OYCR throughout the duration of the contract.
