❖ ***Chief Tracie Neal, Shasta County Probation***

Tracie Neal is the Chief Probation Officer of Shasta County. Chief Neal has worked in the field of probation services and community corrections since 1996. In 2012, she was hired by Shasta County as the Assistant Chief Probation Officer and has been the Chief Probation Officer since 2013

❖ ***Chief Robert Reyes, San Luis Obispo County Probation***

Robert Reyes was appointed as the Chief Probation Officer for San Luis Obispo County on October 17, 2020. He was hired by the Probation Department in 1998 and has served in a variety of assignments including Deputy Probation Officer, Supervising Deputy Probation Officer, Training Manager, Juvenile Hall Superintendent, and Chief Deputy Probation Officer. Robert was the Assistant Chief Probation Officer from August 2015 to October 2021.

❖ ***Assistant Chief Tom Milder, San Luis Obispo County Probation***

Tom Milder has over twenty-five (25) years of experience working in Probation in San Luis Obispo County, starting as a Juvenile Services Officer working in the Juvenile Hall and ultimately promoting to Assistant Chief Probation Officer, where his scope of responsibility currently includes oversight of the Adult, Juvenile, Juvenile Custody and Support Services Divisions. Tom spent the majority of his career in Juvenile Services, where he was involved with multiple implementation efforts including the Home Supervision program, Juvenile Drug Court program, Assembly Bill 12/Extended Foster Care, Continuum of Care Reform, the Coastal Valley Academy and Division of Juvenile Justice Realignment.
