Will there be further time for public comment after today's webinar?	Yes, significant discussion has required a change in the timeline. There will be a future opportunity for public comment on this and all P&Ps.
6	DeeAnne McCallin, California Primary Care Association	Comment (not question): "Information Blocking" has never made sense, is counter intuitive. I do like the prefix "CA" suggestion.	This is why I recommended reference to "Information Sharing requirements" and/or "Information Blocking prohibitions".
