LA County Child Protection Hotline Reform

Hotline 2 Helpline Program



- Makes services and supports available to families with evaluated out referrals
- Prevention and Aftercare Networks (CBOs) outreach to families
 - Utilizes multidisciplinary team process
- 2022 focus on targeted increase of Black families safely deferred
- Less likely to have a subsequent substantiated allegation
- Less likely to experience removal and placement in out-of-home care

 - Consequences of oversurveillance






LA County Mandated Supporting Initiative

Consequences of Oversurveillance



- Fear + Trauma + Toxic Stress
 - weaponized family separation
 - generational trauma
 - compounding effect
- Disrupted Trust
 - less likely to seek support
- CPS Record
 - strike against the family
- Overburdening the System
 - fewer resources for children who truly are unsafe
