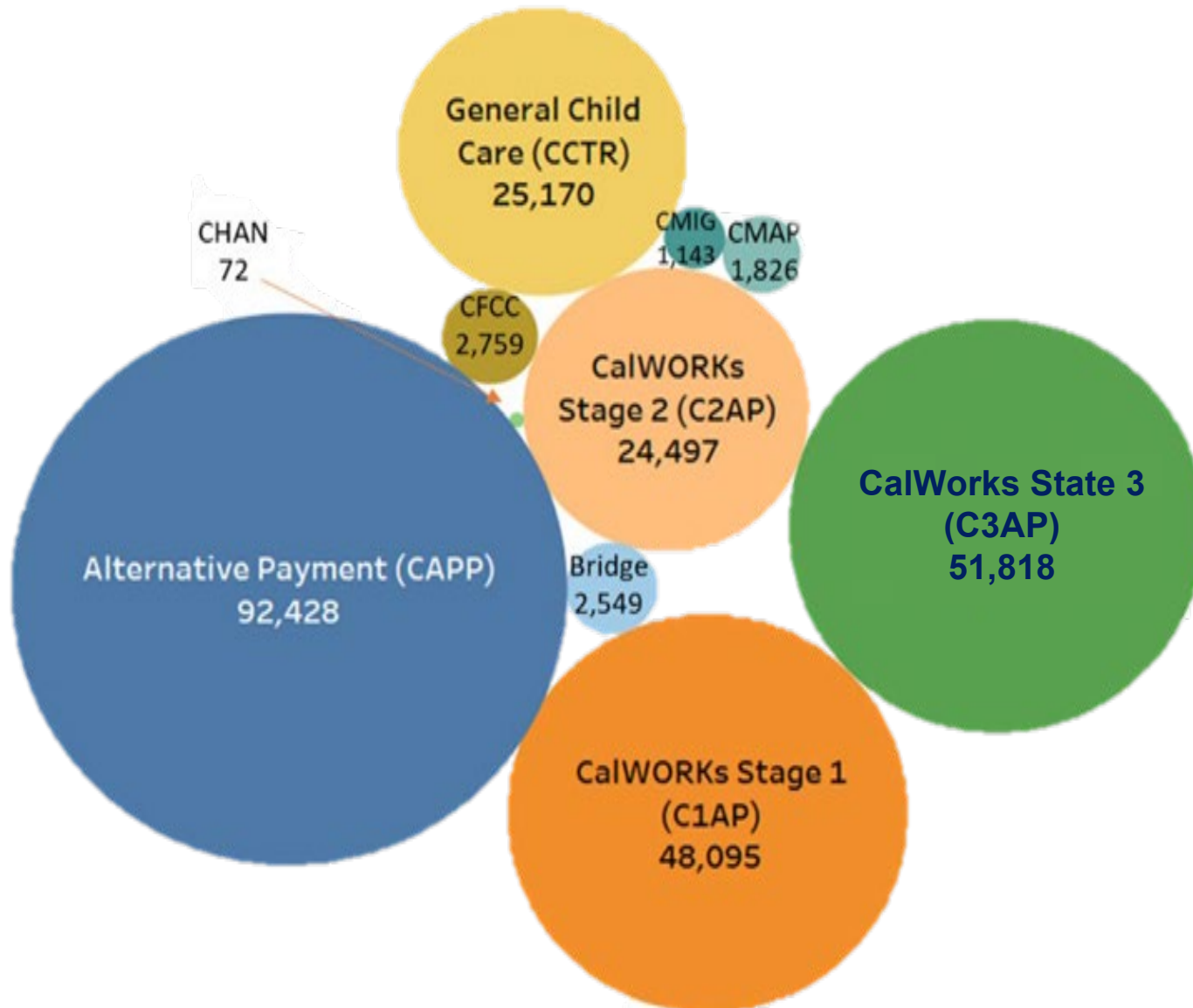

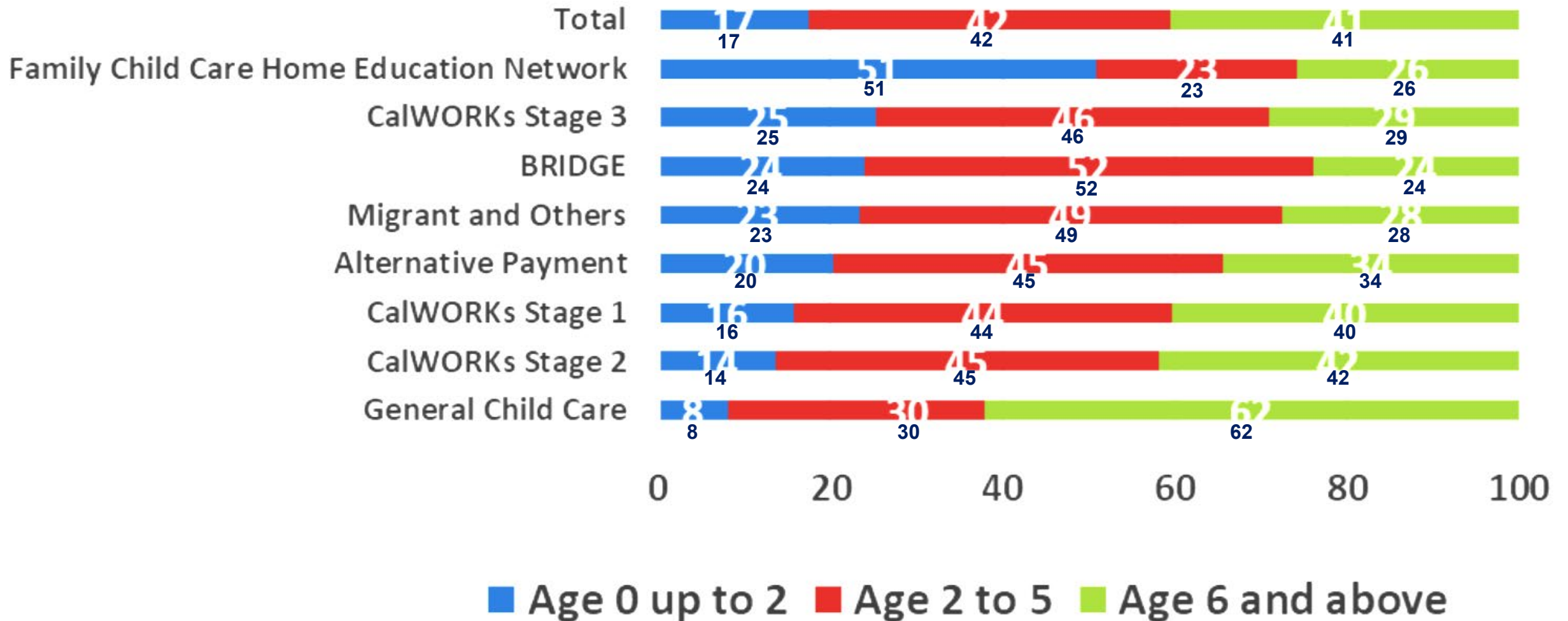

Enrollments by Contract Type – Monthly Average

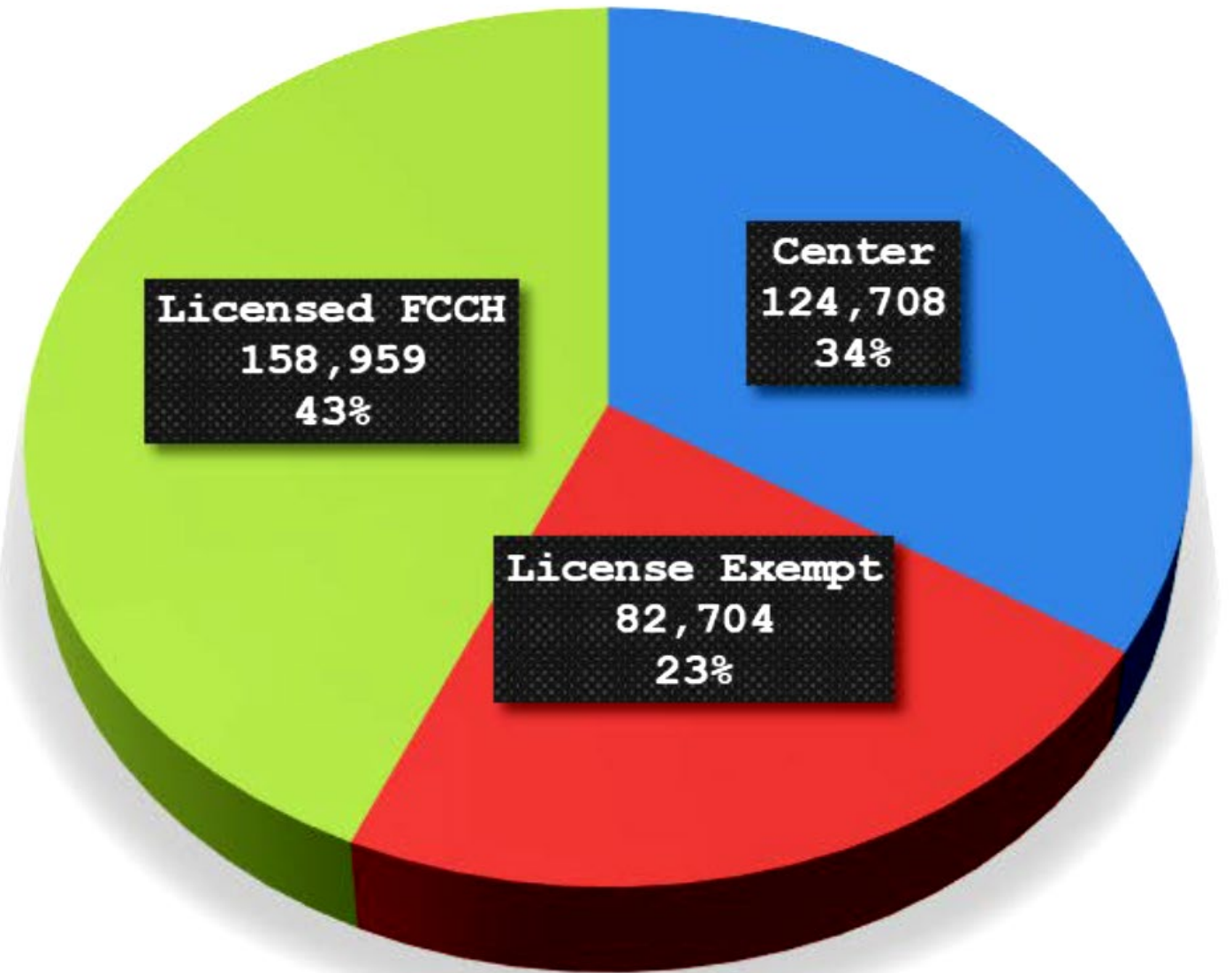


Child counts are unduplicated within each contract type. A child may be counted more than once if they received services within multiple contract types during the year. The total sum of all the contract types is a duplicated number.

Child Age Caseload Summary

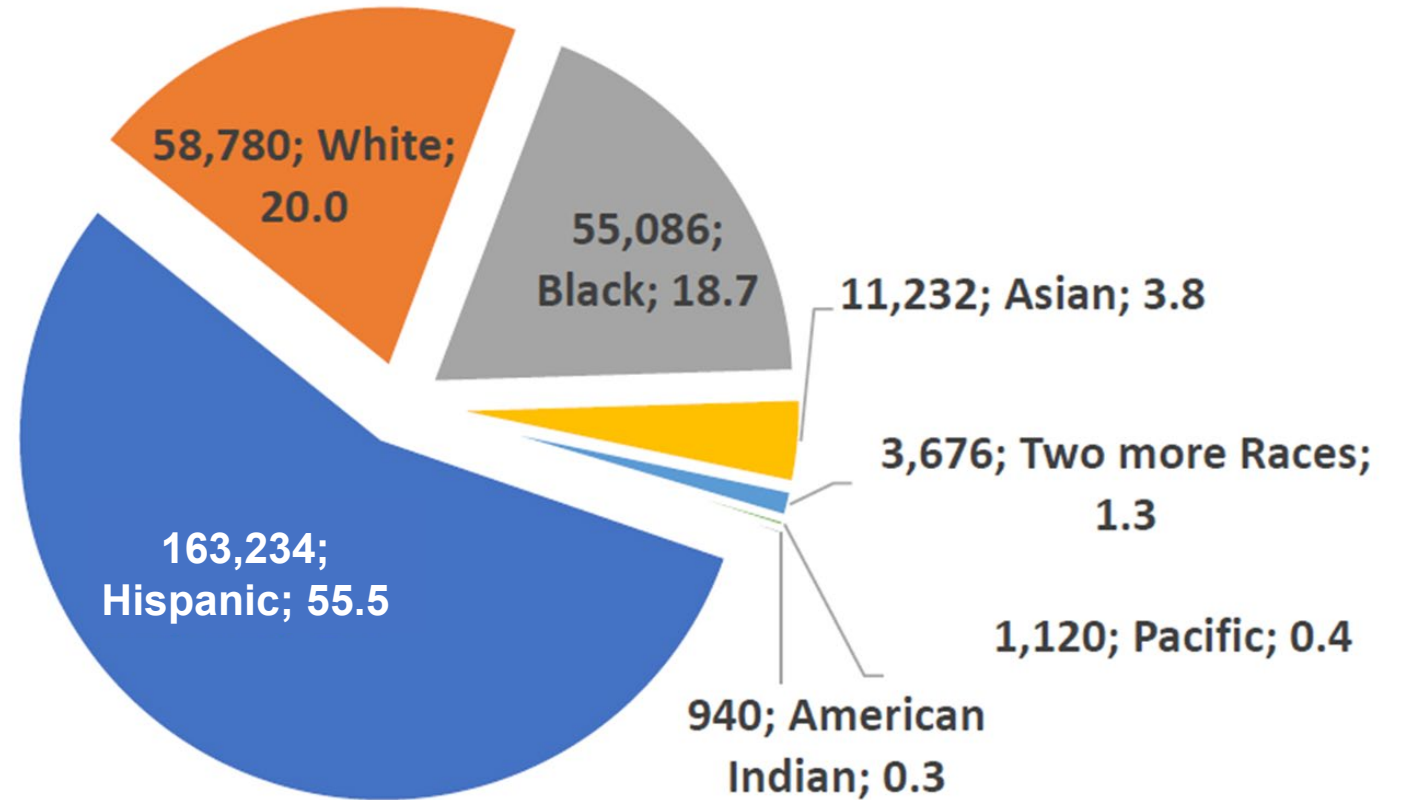

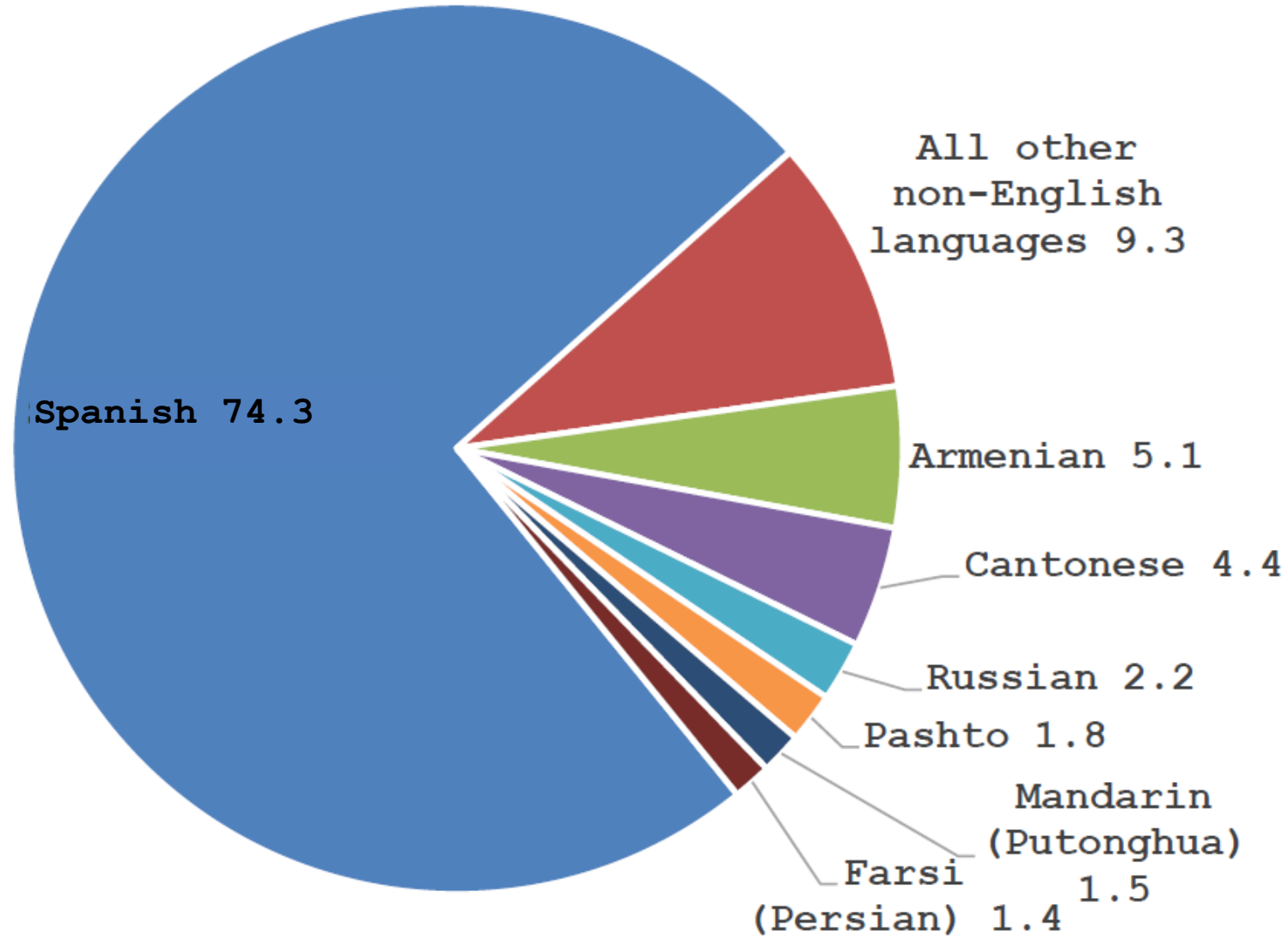


Child Race/Ethnicity

- Draft 2025-27 CCDF released for a 30-day comment period
 - February 1, 2024 – March 1, 2024, 5:00pm
 - Public hearing scheduled for Wednesday, March 6, 2024, 10:00am - 12:00pm
 - Final will be submitted July 1, 2024
 - Effective October 1, 2024 – September 30, 2027

- Alternative Methodology Timeline & Next Steps

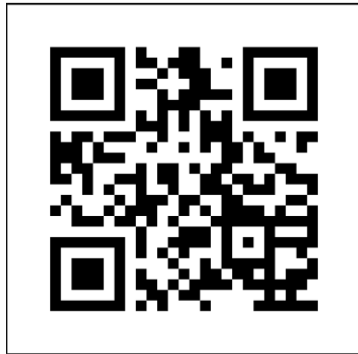
