OYCR Ombudsperson Division Complaint Data

Current as of January 31, 2025

- **Complaints - 558**

- 425 closed, 133 open
- 350 opened in 2024
- 330 complaints from youth
- 228 complaints from others

- **Site Visits - 85**

- 62 annual (AB 505)
- 23 investigative

- **Top Issues**

- Abuse/punishment
- Staffing
- Family engagement
- Education

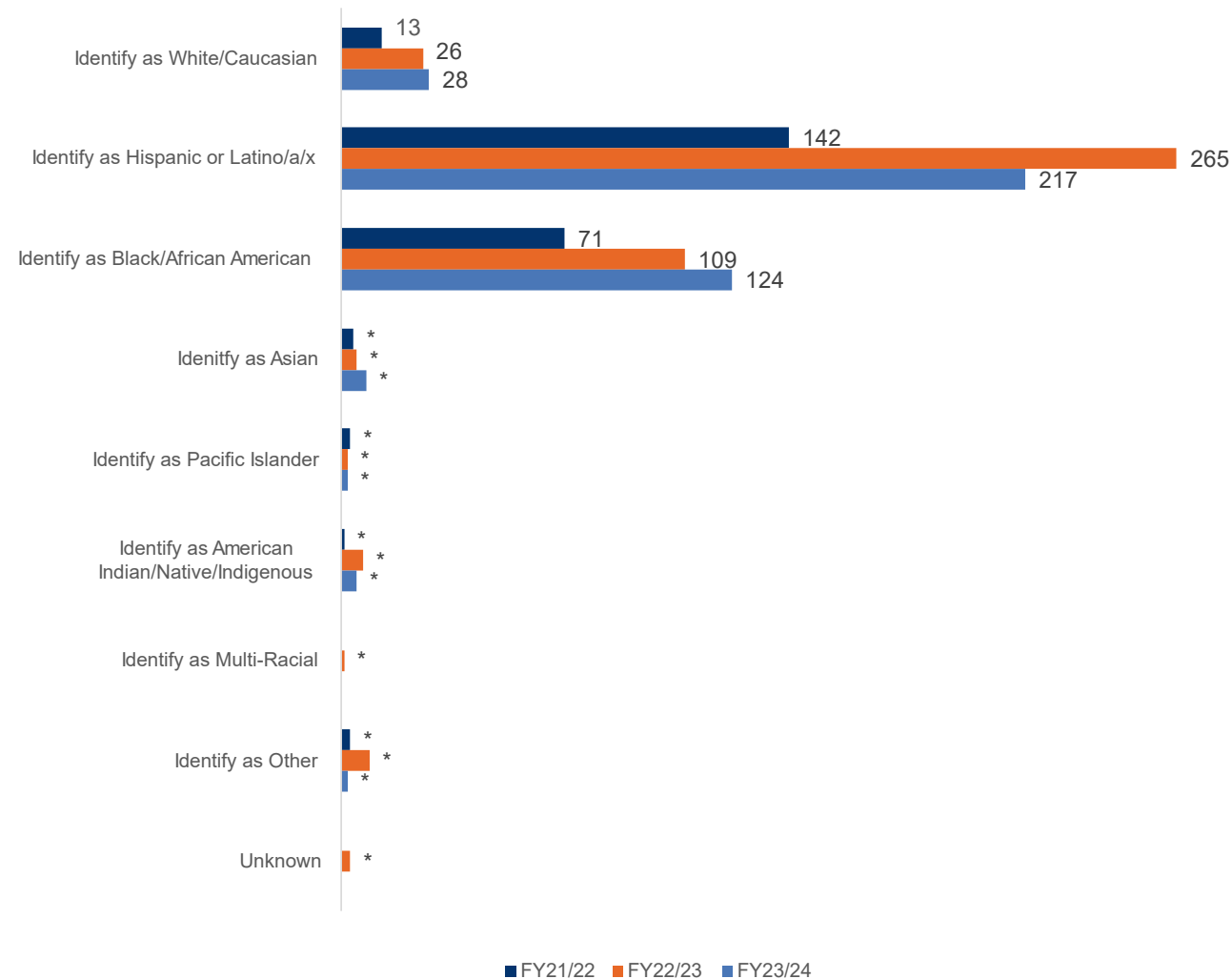

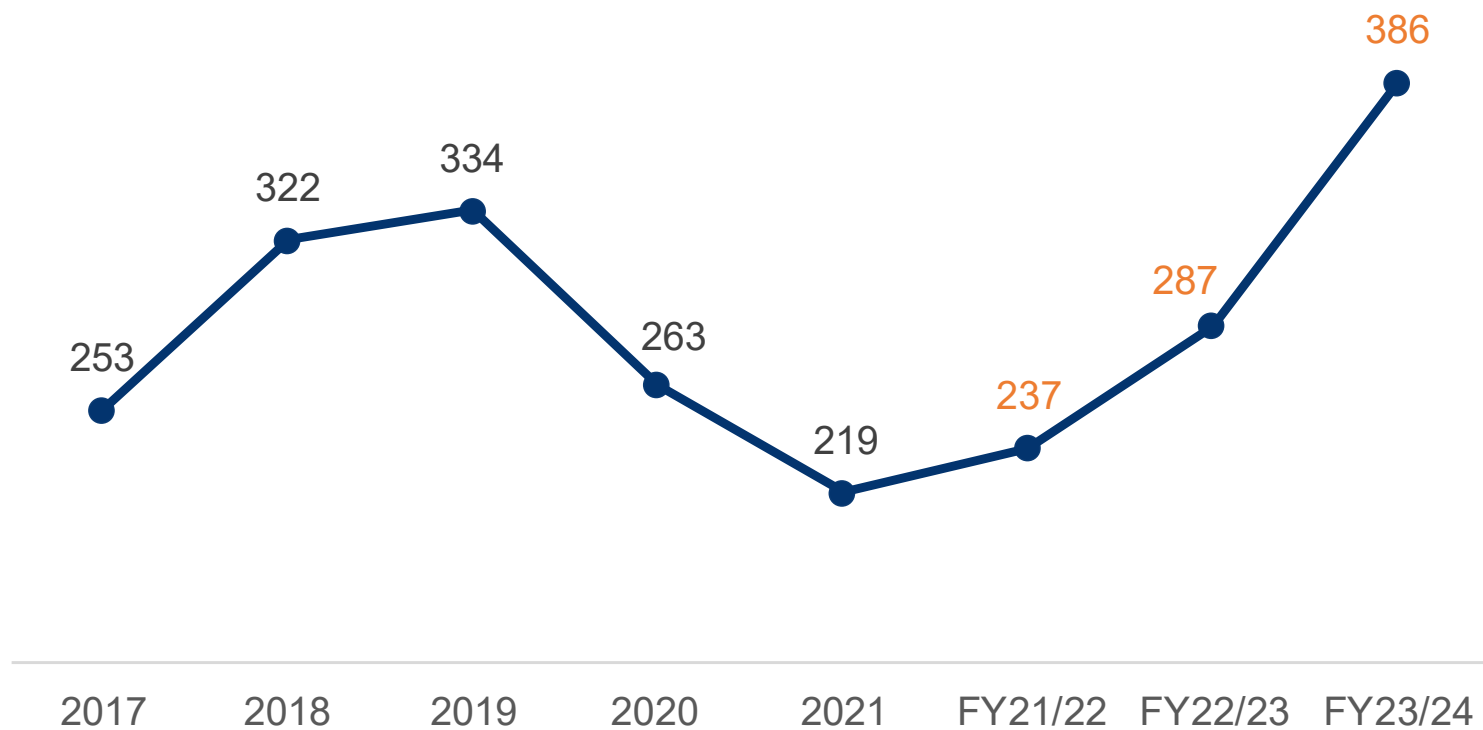

Overrepresentation of Youth of Color in SYTFs

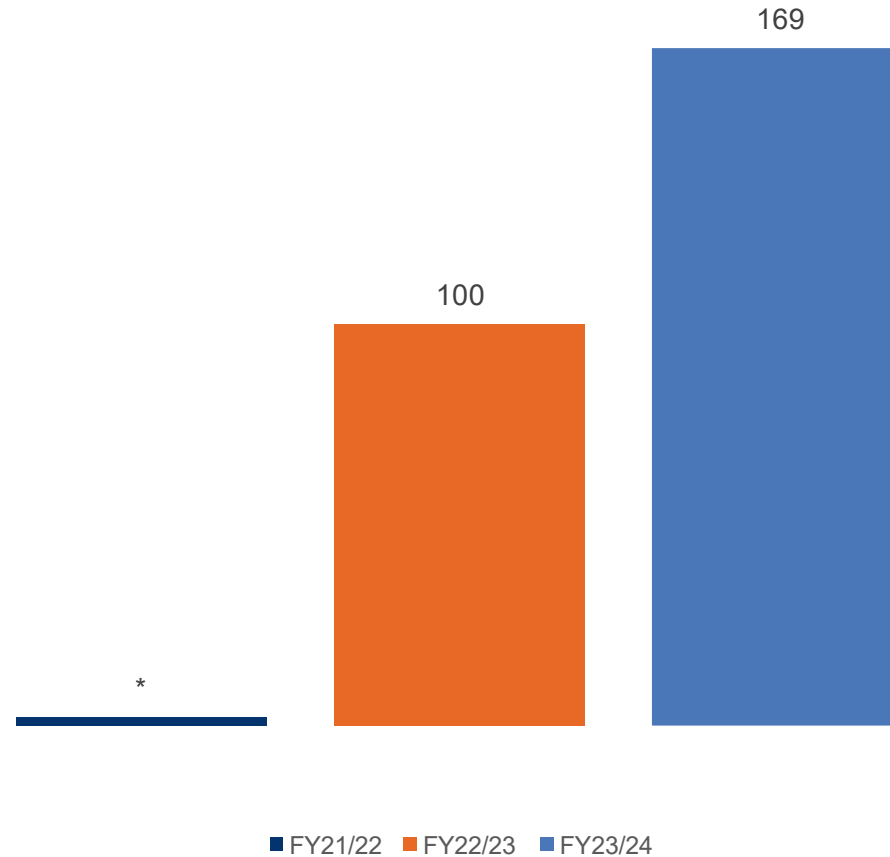


Statewide Net Widening

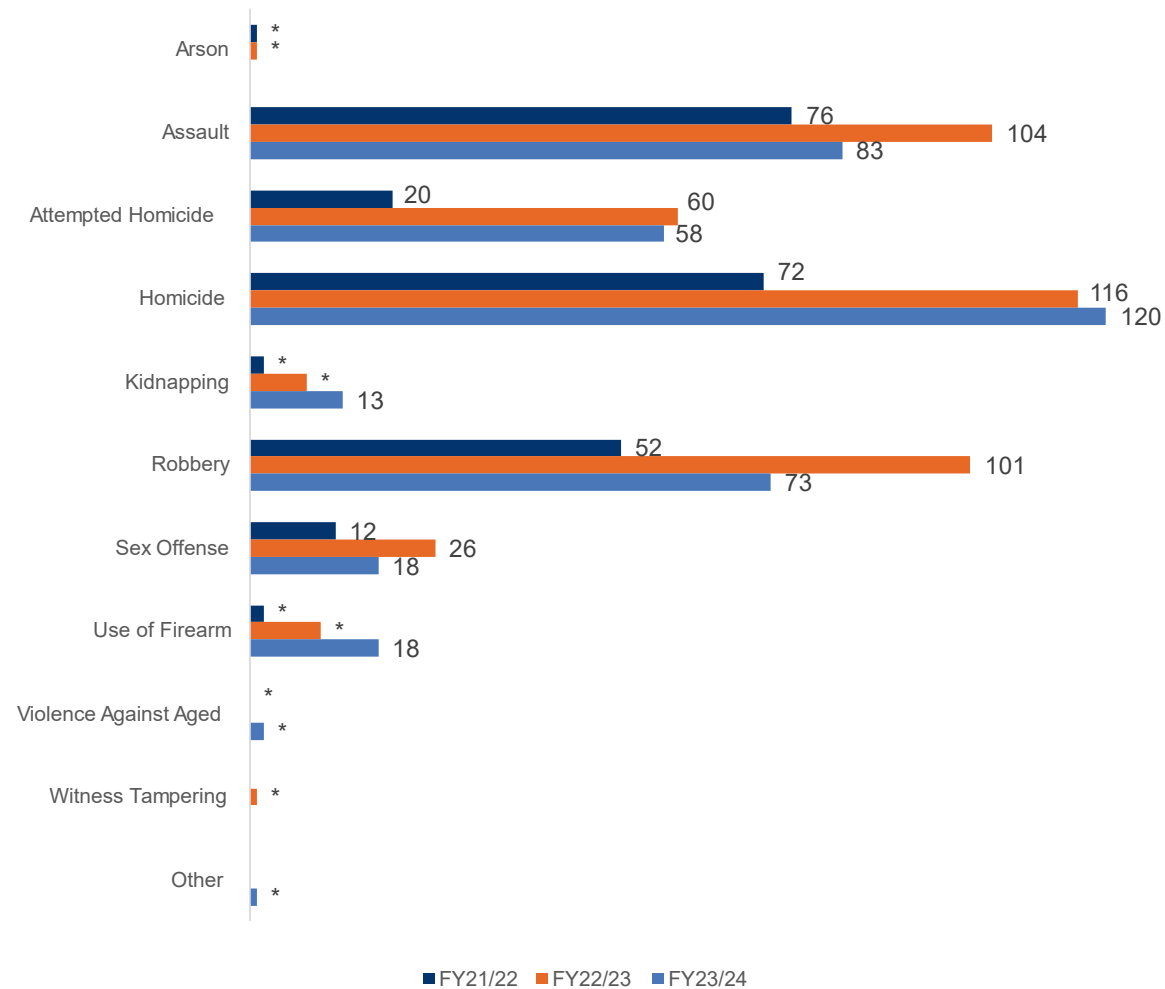
